SUMMARY EXPLANATION/BACKGROUND:

In 2012, at the conclusion of a multi-year process, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) approved Deerfield Beach's 'locally preferred alternative' for the future configuration of A1A. The study and planning process evaluated alternatives such as rerouting A1A behind the Wyndham Hotel or creating one way pairs using NE 20th Avenue. In the end, the locally preferred alternative plan adopted by the City Commission was to reconstruct A1A on its existing route, widening key sections, signaling the curve by the International Fishing Pier entrance, and adding sidewalks, bike lanes, improved drainage, lighting, and landscaping along the entire corridor.

The engineering drawings needed to construct the **FHWA project** described above are currently being prepared as a joint effort between the City and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). Federal funding for design had been pre-authorized contingent upon FHWA's approval of the plan. However, no funding has been identified for construction. The cost estimate for implementation is \$13 to \$16 million, including the needed right-of-way acquisition and business damages. An e-mail from FDOT (attached) explains that the project has "a very low priority in the Long Range Transportation Plan (8 out of 10)".

At the same time, plans are underway by FDOT for a **3R project** along A1A. 3R stands for resurfacing, restoration, and rehabilitation. This is a much smaller-scale project and it is funded for implementation in 2015. The attached e-mail indicates that FDOT will add funding to the 3R project in order to add sidewalks and bike lanes when they do the resurfacing. However, the necessary right-of way does not exist in some places, and in some cases there are existing parking spaces that will need to be removed or relocated. To implement this option, FDOT would seek the City's assistance in resolving the encroachments and obtaining easements.

The two options outlined below are intended to set a range of alternatives. There are other potential approaches to the set of circumstances described above.

- 1) A City Commission resolution directing staff to pursue A) the cancellation of the design contract with Metric Engineering for the reconstruction of A1A following the approved FHWA project, B) the re-allocation of the funds designated therefore toward the inclusion of additional enhancements in the Florida Department of Transportation's planned 3R resurfacing project, and C) the easement approvals and encroachment removals needed to accomplish such additional enhancements.

Mr. Klopp –

I appreciate your cooperation in finalizing the scope of the work to be included in the upcoming FDOT resurfacing project on SR A-1-A in Deerfield Beach. As discussed at our recent meeting, below is a description of the two FDOT projects in the area as well as documentation describing how the FDOT intends to proceed with the two projects.

There are two ongoing design projects for SR A1A, in Deerfield Beach, from SE 3rd St to SE 31st St. Metric Engineering is preparing the design plans to implement the improvements from the approved PD&E project (FM#420416.1). At the same time, BES, Inc. is developing the design plans for a resurfacing (RRR) project (FM#430595.1, scheduled for construction FY 15). The scope of the RRR project was limited to just milling and resurfacing the existing roadway since the PD&E project will take care of more significant improvements like sidewalks, bike lanes, etc., that require R/W acquisition.

The next phases of the PD&E project currently have a very low priority in the Long Range Transportation Plan (8 out of 10). In addition, the PD&E is currently funded for design only with no funding for right of way or construction in the next five years. In light of these issues, the Broward MPO requested the FDOT to study the possibility of adding sidewalks and bike lanes as part of the RRR project. Since these types of improvements (bike lanes and sidewalks) are typically included under an FDOT resurfacing project, the FDOT decided to prepare concept plans including these elements. Attached is a roll plot and typical sections with the preliminary concept plans for SR A1A. The highlighted areas depict the encroachments that will need to be resolved with some property owners in order to implement this design. Some drainage improvements will be needed in order to accommodate the bike lanes and the additional impervious area. Adding these elements to the project will increase the construction cost by approximate \$500,000 dollars which will be included in the FDOT funding of the project. Any additional items requested by the City or County may require local funding participation. FDOT is working to keep the same schedule and meet our scheduled plans production date of October 2014 and construction contract bid opening in February 2015.

Please review this information and let me know if you have any comments or concerns. I look forward to continuing our partnership with both the City and the MPO to deliver a project that meets the expectations of everyone involved.

Dear Mr. Olson and Mr. Gutierrez:

Thank you to FDOT and MPO for meeting with City of Deerfield Beach staff recently to discuss the FHWA-approved PD&E locally preferred alternative project and the FDOT 3R project, each as pertains to A1A in Deerfield Beach. At such meeting we discussed the needs along the corridor as well as the timeframes, costs, priority levels, and funding potentials for the two projects. The FDOT and MPO indicated in the meeting that, taking all of these things into consideration, *the intent is to incorporate some of the elements of the PD&E project into the 3R project*. The design plans for the PD&E-approved project are underway by Metric Engineering. Meanwhile BES is preparing the design plans for the 3R. We discussed many of the specific challenges each of them face in their designs.

In response to my inquiry, you agreed to respond in writing to a request that FDOT and the MPO *explain the situation and detail those things mentioned above in writing*. As I pointed out during the meeting, there is substantial resident and business interest in the future plans for the corridor, much of it having been engaged via the PD&E process; City staff needs to be able to present the status to -- and confidently manage the expectations of -- those stakeholders and the local elected officials. This is particularly important as it pertains to those elements that may be added to the 3R project, but would differ from the PD&E concept or alter it substantially.

Thank you again for your time. I look forward to continuing our coordination and cooperation.



Project Description

This project is being done as a collaborative effort between the City of Deerfield Beach and the Florida Department of Transportation. The project consists of approximately a 0.84 mile portion of SR-A1A in Broward County within the City of Deerfield Beach city limits. The project begins at SE 3rd Street to the south and terminates at NE 7th Street to the north at the Broward County/Palm Beach County line. Mobility and safety improvements will be provided for this primarily 2-lane undivided urban principal collector.

Design Improvements


- Provision of new bicycle lanes.
- Provision of new sidewalks.
- Provision of additional pedestrian crosswalks.
- Improvements at the intersection of SR A1A/NE 21 Ave and NE 2 St which includes installation of a signal and the addition of a southbound right turn lane.
- Addition of drop curbs where abutting parking is currently present.
- Curb and gutter where required by safety standards such as along the curves.

REQUESTED ACTION:

Approve resolution authorizing Bermello Ajamil & Partners' scope of services for Sullivan Park Expansion - Phase 2 Services (Design, Construction Drawings and Construction Administration) in an amount not to exceed \$397,430.00.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION/BACKGROUND:

At the November 12, 2013 CRA Board meeting, the staff presented the CRA Board with a detailed cost estimate for the construction of the improvements shown on the Sullivan Park Master Plan and scaled-back implementation options. The Board directed the CRA Director to negotiate a scope of services with Bermello Ajamil & Partners for the complete implementation of the Sullivan Park Master Plan – Phase 2 (Design, Construction Drawings and Construction Administration). The proposed scope of services is attached to this item hereby requesting Board approval.

Concurrent with contract negotiations, CRA staff submitted the Sullivan Park Master Plan to the Community Appearance Board (CAB) where it was approved unanimously at the November 20th meeting. Staff subsequently submitted the plan to the Planning and Zoning (P&Z) Board where it was also unanimously approved at the December 5th meeting. Members of both Boards made positive comments about the plan. Finally, the Sullivan Park Master Plan was approved unanimously by the City Commission at the January 14th meeting.

The proposed scope of services is a turnkey design and construction administration work plan. Because the starting point for design is a master plan with limited design details, the scope of work includes project management measures to ensure that the CRA Board and the public have additional opportunities for input, project scope control, and associated level of cost decision-making. Prior to 50% design, B&A will meet with the Marine Advisory Board at a public meeting to collect advisory input on the marine features of the park – namely the dock and pier facilities. At 50% design, the CRA will solicit a cost estimate from an authorized independent third party Consultants Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) consultant. This cost estimate and 50% design will be presented to the CRA Board. This decision-making stage will allow the Board to evaluate park features and associated costs.

The project will be presented to the Board again at the 90% design phase. The CRA will again be able to solicit a cost estimate to evaluate the project prior to completion of construction drawings. If significant changes have not been made to the project following 50% design, the CRA Board may opt to forgo an additional cost estimate at this stage, but has the option to do so. The CRA will solicit a final cost estimate at 100% design. This final estimate will inform the Board of the cost of full master plan implementation and be used in evaluating contractor bids.

While the proposed scope of services will result in construction drawings for the full implementation of the master plan, the Board still has the option of implementing all or portions of the master plan. The construction bid documents can be drafted to ask bidders to bid on a base design with separate bids for optional features, for example. The award of the construction contract will be the final opportunity for the Board to give direction on the implementation of desired park features. After the award of the construction contract, changes in project scope will result in change orders.

Increases or decreases in project scope and cost will allow the CRA to renegotiate B&A design fees at the 50% design point. Increases to project scope after 50% design will result in additional design fees. Decreases in project scope after 50% design will not impact the scope of services and associated fees.

B&A will be responsible for project permitting, bidding and construction administration. Construction administration is based on a 12 month construction schedule. If a traffic study is deemed necessary or desirable, encumbered funds from the Phase 1 purchase order remain available as one was not conducted as part of the Phase 1 Master Plan.

If approved by the Board, a notice to proceed will be issued. The project schedule is included in the scope of services and shows 50% completion by August, 90% drawings by December and complete construction drawings by February. Sullivan Park improvements would be completed by July 2016. The project schedule is a conservative estimate. B&A and CRA staff anticipate an earlier completion unless unforeseen circumstances arise. These benchmarks are consistent with CRA staff's original project schedule.

The budget for Phase 2 is consistent with staff projections and the cost estimate presented to the CRA Board in November. 50% of this contract is eligible for reimbursement under the FIND Waterways Assistance Program once a construction contract is executed. Adequate funding is available in account #386-8000-572.61-08 (Architecture/Engineering) for this expense.

City of Deerfield Beach Sullivan Park Expansion Project - Phase Two Proposal



INTRODUCTION

This proposal provides the City with a detailed Scope of Services for the next phase of the expansion of Sullivan Park project. The Master Plan for the park as illustrated in Attachment B has been approved and shall serve as the basis for the Phase Two work effort to provide professional consulting services to carry the project on through Detailed Design, Construction Drawings and Construction Administration.

TEAM ORGANIZATION

Attachment A is an organizational chart which illustrates the structure of the Design Team we propose for Phase Two. The team members are the same members that were provided to the City of Deerfield Beach in our original response to the City's RFQ #2012-13/09.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

The proposed scope of work is for professional services for the design, preparation of construction documents, specifications and construction administration for the approved Master Plan for the park. Included in that plan are the following major park plan components:

- Restroom building , +/- 1,100 square feet. Program anticipates: up to one toilet and two urinals plus two sinks for men's restroom and three toilets and two sinks for women's restroom; of which one shall be an ADA handicap stall for each. Note that a family restroom is not included. In addition, the building will include a small storage closet, janitor's closet and electrical room space permitting. If the City alters the building program with additional uses or significant changes to the area of the stated uses, B&A will work with the City and modify the fees accordingly.
- Open-air pavilion with concrete pad, columns and roof. (similar size in SF to restroom building)
- Stair tower for pedestrian access from the Hillsboro Blvd. bridge. (An elevator and/or handicap ramp is not included in this scope of work).
- Playgrounds (2) with sail type shade coverings
- Marina (13 slips) with finger piers
- Floating dock
- Walkways and waterfront promenade

- Parking for +/-66 vehicles
- Interactive water feature
- Site facilities including:
 - benches
 - bike racks
 - picnic tables
 - waste receptacles
 - drinking fountains
- Park Lighting for vehicular and pedestrian areas including specialty lighting
- Entry and directional signage
- Interpretive signage
- Fencing/screening

SCOPE OF WORK

The proposed scope of work shall include the following disciplines:

- Landscape Architecture
- Architecture
- Structural Engineering
- Mechanical Electrical and Plumbing Engineering
- Irrigation Design
- Signage and Wayfinding
- Fountain Design and Engineering
- Surveying

The professional services shall consist of the following tasks:

- Task 1 – Design (Schematic Design and Design Development)
- Task 2 – Construction Documents and Specifications
- Task 3 – Permitting
- Task 4 - Bidding and Contractor Selection
- Task 5 - Construction Administration

A detailed description of the scope of services included in this work authorization is broken down as follows:

Task 1

DESIGN (Schematic Design and Design Development)

Task 1 shall focus on developing the park program components in further detail including the overall spatial requirements, massing, orientation, placement and look, feel, style and architecture of the exterior of the site buildings. Task 1 will also develop all hardscape, landscape and park elements as indicated above in the Scope of Services. Task 1 shall include City presentations of design development options and design submittals.

Prior to any design work started in Task 1, B&A shall conduct an Electromagnetic Survey of the property to determine the location of all underground utilities. The fees for this work includes ten (10) test holes on the site. All utility locations shall be placed on the topographic survey produced in Phase 1.

Task 2**CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS & SPECIFICATIONS**

Construction documents shall be prepared as required for permit and construction for the three structures and park elements listed above. The fees to develop the construction drawings and specifications are based on the approved Master Plan and an estimated total construction cost of \$4,776,000.00.

Any redesign of the plans after the construction drawings are completed to reduce construction costs below the above amount shall require additional services. If the City increases the construction value and/or park facilities over and above what are indicated on the approved attached Master Plan, B&A shall renegotiate the scope and fees. Construction drawings shall be submitted to the City at 50%, 90% and 100% completion. The City is responsible for carrying out a detailed cost estimate of the 50% plan submission. If the estimated total construction fees are lower or higher than the above total construction fees and the program components have not changed, B&A will renegotiate the consultant fees for the remaining work following the 50% submission. All redesign and adjustments to the plans to reduce the overall construction costs are additional services.

The fees in this scope include outline specifications to be indicated on the plan sheets.

Task 3**PERMITTING AND AGENCY APPROVALS**

B&A shall provide the City with professional services for all permitting and City agency submissions and respond to all permit and agency comments. This will include CRA, CAB, P&Z, FDOT, FDEP, Army Corps of Engineers, SFWMD, Broward County Environmental Protection, City of Deerfield Beach City Commission and the City of Deerfield Beach Building Department. Permit application fees are not included in this scope and fee proposal. The City is responsible for all application and permitting fees. B&A shall attend one (1) workshop with the Marine Advisory Board for their review and comments and up to two (2) meetings of each of the City's boards including the CRA, CAB and P&Z. Additional meetings shall be billed on a time and materials basis.

Task 4**BIDDING AND CONTRACTOR SELECTION**

B&A shall provide assistance for bidding and contractor selection services to the City after completion of the construction documents as noted below:

- Respond to bidder questions regarding project elements and clarification or interpretations of the bidding documents
- Preparation of addenda for distribution by the City
- Attendance at up to two pre-bid meetings with City and contractors
- Preparation of a bid tabulation list
- Documentation of bidding results, (distribution of results by City)
- Evaluation of the bid tabulation with a recommendation for award based on bid values

Task 5**CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION**

Construction services are included in conjunction with the scope of work defined above and shall include the following:

- B&A shall receive and log shop drawings and technical submittals required to be submitted by the Construction Contractor. B&A [and its sub-consultants] shall review and return submittals to the contractor within ten working days of receipt and transmit these submittals to the City for their record / review. The review shall be in accordance with the project specifications and for conformance with the design concept and compliance with the Contract Documents.

This proposal includes B&A visiting one (1) "local" nursery to review plant material selected by the contractor per the specifications on the plans. Additional nursery visits shall be charged on a time and material basis. If a nursery visit is not required, this scope and fees includes a single separate site visit by the B&A Landscape Architect to review plant materials prior to installation.

B&A [and its sub-consultants] shall issue technical interpretations and clarifications of the Contract Documents, along with associated support materials, as requested by City staff. These interpretations shall be rendered and a response prepared and submitted to City staff within one (1) week.

B&A shall attend a project meeting and visit the project site to observe the progress and quality of work once every two (2) weeks during the period of construction. B&A shall also respond to any RFI's during the construction. It is assumed, herein, that B&A shall not provide daily inspection, construction oversight or construction management. B&A must be present for all construction activities which shall require certification at close out. Contractor shall be responsible for notifying B&A of any such site activities. The basis for the fee proposal is a 12 month construction period. If construction extends beyond this time frame, B&A shall renegotiate the fees for this Task based on the expected extended construction period.

During construction, it shall be the responsibility of the contractor to provide B&A with red line drawings of the plans clearly indicating any changes to the issued permit drawings. Based on the information provided by the Contractor, B&A will update the permitted plans to reflect changes the contractor has indicated on their submitted red line plans. The record drawings will be available to the City in digital format.

B&A shall provide professional services for close out of the project once construction has been completed. B&A shall conduct one (1) site visit and prepare a punch list of items that do not meet the intent and specifications of the plans and documents. B&A shall conduct one (1) final follow-up site visit to review the punch list and confirm that all items have been addressed by the contractor. Additional site visits by B&A or its sub consultants to review Contractor's modifications or changes shall be charged as additional services on a time and material basis.

NOTE: *All plans and documents shall be provided to the City in digital format. The costs associated with producing the minimum required number of printed plans and documents are included in the*

total fees. Additional requested printed copies of plans and documents shall be charged under reimbursable expenses not included in the fees provided below.

REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES

Reimbursable expenses shall only be utilized for items not within the above scope of work. Any reimbursable expenses approved by the Client will be itemized and billed at actual costs and include, but not be limited to, photocopies and printing, postage and shipping, long distance telephone, faxes and all travel related expenses.

COMPENSATION

B&A shall be compensated for the work outlined in this proposal on a lump sum basis, as per the terms and conditions Pursuant to Agreement between the City of Deerfield Beach and B&A for continuing contract for Professional Architectural and Engineering Services.
