COMMUNITY PARKS

The City of Deerfield Beach Parks and Recreation Department is comprised of eight divisions: Administration, Recreation, Teen Center, Athletics & Aquatics, Ocean Rescue, Parks Maintenance, Cemetery and the Pier. The Department's mission is to foster the well being of Deerfield Beach's diverse community by maintaining beautiful parks, the beach, municipal cemeteries and the pier as well as preserving the environment and providing enriching recreational programs and activities.

The Department oversees and maintains approximately 470 acres of open space, medians, rights-of-way, miscellaneous areas, parks, the beach and city owned property. This acreage is located at over 190 sites city-wide. Our residents enjoy a 976-foot International Pier, a one-mile stretch of public beach, jogging/walking trails and over 30 public parks. The Pioneer Park Tennis Center consists of six hard courts, plus there are six additional tennis courts located throughout the parks system. The Department also offers a full-size gymnasium, several outdoor basketball courts and 28 playgrounds.

The city has three community centers and collaborates with the School Board of Broward County in a proactive inter-local agreement to manage the Middle School Athletics and Aquatics Complex and the Quiet Waters Athletic Complex. Through the Parks and Recreation Department the city also maintains two municipal cemeteries, Memorial and Pineview.

Constitution Park

2841 W. Hillsboro Blvd. Located in Deer Creek, offers over eight acres of beautifully landscaped trails and amenities. Constitution Park is home to our Arboretum (Tree Zoo) with over 325 exotic trees displayed along a one-half mile path, the "Zeke" Landis Nursery, and rainforest. The park offers two lighted tennis courts, a lighted basketball court, playground, picnic shelters and a paved jogging trail. The recreation center houses a meeting room and a full service recreation room.

Ada Graham-Johnson Park

156 SW 34th Avenue. Picnic tables and playgrounds.

Cornerstone Park

1420 SE 3rd Avenue. This park has multiple play stations under a shade canopy. For adults this park offers picnic tables and benches along with grills.

Crystal Heights Parks

SW 28th Avenue, SW 24th Terrace and SW 10th Drive. Picnic tables, playgrounds and a sand volleyball court (at 28th Avenue).

Deer Run Park

SW 31st Avenue. Picnic tables and playgrounds.

Deerfield Beach Middle School Athletic Complex

501 SE 6th Avenue. The athletic fields, 10.8 acres, include four baseball fields, batting cages and a football/soccer field with a quarter mile track. The park also has a multi-use building which houses the city's Athletics Offices, a concession stand and restrooms. The Aquatic Center has a competition and teaching pool, administrative offices, a multipurpose area for meetings, restrooms and locker rooms.

Ecidar Park

SW 15th Street. Gazebo, playground, jogging trail and tennis courts.

Highlands Park

511 NE 44th Street. Community Center and playground.

Johnie McKeithen Park

629 N Deerfield Avenue. Playgrounds, half basketball court, picnic tables, boat dock, pavilion with restrooms and trail with exercise stations.

Mayo Howard Park

1131 SW 11th Way. Playground, picnic facilities, pavilion, and fitness trail with exercise stations.

Municipal Pier & Beach

SW 21st Avenue. The City owns, operates, and guards over one mile of public beach along the ocean. Take a refreshing stroll down the landscaped paths along the ocean or, for a nominal fee you may enjoy the 976-foot municipal fishing pier. Also offered along the beach are volleyball courts, gazebos, and boardwalk rentals. Beach wheel chairs are available behind lifeguard tower 3.

Oveta McKeithen Recreational Complex

445 SW 2nd Street. This 15 acre park offers a full-service recreation center, full-size gym, picnic areas and a playground. Improvements include a multi-purpose building that houses a press box, concession stand and restrooms, a football/soccer field, lighted outdoor basketball courts, and 2 baseball fields & a multi-purpose field.

Pioneer Park

222 NE 2nd Avenue. This 13.7-acre park along the water includes lighted baseball fields, picnic areas, a playground facility, tennis facility and a boat ramp leading into the Hillsboro Canal with ocean access.

Quiet Waters Athletic Park

4150 West Hillsboro Blvd. This facility has a lighted baseball/softball diamond and a large multiuse soccer/football field.

Riverglen Park

300 NW 45th Avenue. Playground and pavilion.

South East 19th Avenue Park

Basketball goal, playground, and picnic tables.

South East 15th Street Park

Playground.

Sullivan Park (Under Construction)

1724 Riverview Road. Boat dock, shuffleboard courts and picnic area.

Tivoli Sand Pine Preserve

SW 10th Street and 3rd Avenue. Natural preserve.

Trailhead Park

3700 American Way. Playground and picnic shelter.

Villages of Hillsboro Park

4111 NW 6th Street. Located in the Villages subdivision, this park offers basketball courts, jogging/in-line skating trails with fitness stations, a sand volleyball court, tennis courts, picnic pavilions and a playground with rubberized surfacing. Bring your boat to take advantage of the boat dock and ramp offered free of charge.

THE BEACH Hillsboro Blvd. & Ocean Way

Visit a “Blue Wave” beach! The City of Deerfield Beach has earned this award designation by The Clean Beach Council based on specific criteria, which includes excellence in water quality, beach conditions, safety services, public information and habitat conservation. The Deerfield Beach Ocean Rescue Division protects a one-mile stretch of beach. With nine lifeguard towers, guards are present 9 AM to 5 PM, 365 days per year. Surfing is only allowed north of the pier. Sand volleyball courts are also located north of the pier. Dogs and alcoholic beverages are prohibited. Beach parking stickers can be purchased at City Hall in the Cashiers office located at 150 NE Second Ave. Beach Parking Stickers are \$100 and are available for City Residents with proof of residency. Stickers will last from the time of purchase until December 31st of that year and will be prorated based on the date of purchase. For stickers call 954.480.4298.

The Deerfield Beach International Fishing Pier facility features a family-friendly restaurant, bait and merchandise shop, and second story public observation tower. The 976 foot Deerfield Beach International Fishing Pier is the crown jewel on our beach, attracting thousands of visitors and fishermen annually.


