


# Constitution Park Arboretum Rainforest Location Map



# Constitution Park Arboretum Rainforest

## ❖ Project Summary

The City Commission was awarded a grant from Broward County in the amount of \$140,000 for the construction of a Rainforest in the Constitution Park Arboretum. The Rainforest encompasses approximately ¾ of an acre in the north east section of the Arboretum, anchored by a very large existing ficus tree at its center. Phase one will include a network of waterfalls, streams and ponds thereby adding the dimension of sound to the Rainforest.

Future phases include extensive landscaping, a deck large enough for a small gathering situated at the base of the ficus tree as well as an elevated observation deck set into the tree itself. Mist heads, simulating a tropical shower will also be added to enhance your experience.

This is expected to be a great educational exhibit demonstrating Rainforest habitats.
